Summit and Interlibrary Loan

It's been a while since we reminded you that you can borrow books and other items from other libraries via two systems: Summit and Interlibrary Loan. Summit refers to the library catalog that almost 40 college and university libraries in the Pacific Northwest share. You can search our catalog at the top of our website in the blank labelled "Search for books, videos, and more." You'll automatically be searching the holdings of the other libraries. You can tell that an item is owned by a different library because it will be labelled "Ship to LCC Library, Free, 3-7 Days." When you see a Summit item you would like to request, click on "Sign In" and enter your L # and LCC passphrase. Then Click the "Ship to LCC Library, Free, 3-7 Days" button. Then click on the "SEND REQUEST" link located at the bottom of the request form. Using our Summit service you have access to millions of additional items. If an item such as a book is unavailable via Summit, you can use our Interlibrary Loan request form to ask us to get a copy for you from further afield. You can also use the Interlibrary Loan Request form to request articles that we don't own in our databases.

Library Study Jam!

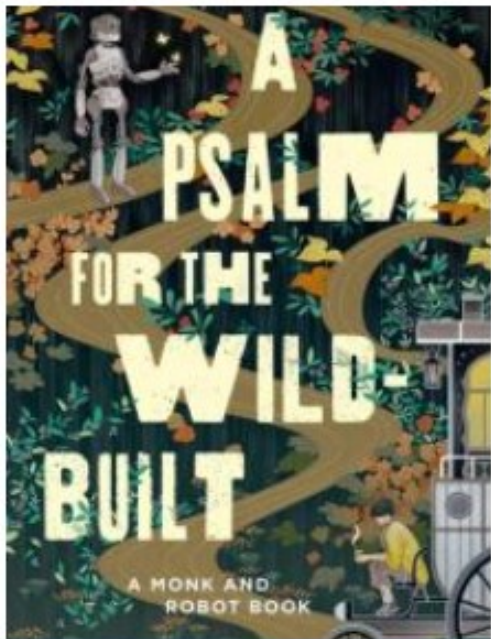
Let your students know that the Library will be hosting a study jam on March 11th. Free pizza, tutors, yoga, and therapy dogs will be on hand.
