Northstar Digital Literacy

The Library has subscribed to a new database called <u>Northstar Digital</u> <u>Literacy</u>, which offers instruction and practice in areas such as keyboard basics and logging in, basic computer skills, internet basics, and more. It takes about 30 minutes for someone who is fairly competent with computers to complete a module. Many are also available in Spanish.

LCC Library + Summit

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In the Library's catalog, Summit items are items that you can request from other libraries. They are usually delivered within 3 to 7 days and held for you at the Library. If you want Summit items to be included in your list of search results, be sure that the catalog is set to search "LCC Library + Summit."

New EBSCO Interface
