


## How to Find Out if the LCC Library Subscribes to a Particular Periodical Searching for Titles of Magazines, Journals, or Newspapers

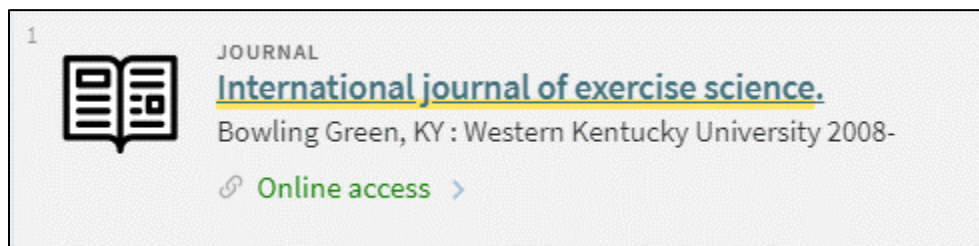
Enter the name of the periodical you are looking for.

Select "LCC Only" instead of "LCC + Summit."

Select "Journal Title" instead of "All Items" and search.

On the results page, click on the title of the journal that interests you:



Look for the place on the page where it says "Full text available at," then click on the hyperlink to the collection that hosts the journal. If we have actual paper copies of the periodical, it will say "Check holdings at LCC Library Periodicals," and you can look for it on the 2nd floor in our periodicals shelves.
